## COURSE STANDARDS

Due to our insurance coverage, all high ropes participants must complete a health history and waiver form prior to climbing.

Participants must be at least 12 years of age for high ropes elements and meet safety requirements.

Participants on the low ropes course must be 8 years of age.

Younger individuals are welcome to attend and offer encouragement. Adults of all ages are welcome to participate on either course.
